



## Ulster County Cooperative Extension Association – County Impact

- As of April 2007, the Cooperative Extension Association of Ulster County employed 24 full- and part-time employees (in FTE’s). Employees working in Ulster County earned about \$0.9 million during the year.
- During 2007, the Cooperative Extension Association spent about \$0.4 million on purchases of goods and services from businesses in the County, accounting for about 3 jobs.
- The Association’s suppliers – and businesses patronized by Association employees – spent money with other county businesses, creating additional jobs and economic activity. Economists refer to these ripple effects as “multiplier effects.”
- Through the multiplier effect, we estimate that the Ulster County Extension Association sustained an additional 4 FTE jobs and \$0.4 million in economic activity in the county during 2007.
- Taking into account spending by the County Association, its employees, and the multiplier effect, we estimate that the Association accounted for about \$1.7 million in economic activity – equivalent to 31 FTE jobs in Ulster County– during 2007.
