Join our Master Gardeners in their award winning Xeriscape Garden at SUNY Ulster for an afternoon stroll on a early autumn afternoon while they explain the principles of drought resistant garden design and planting techniques which create a spectacularly lush and colorful garden. Featuring perennial herbs, flowers and shrubs, the Xeriscape Garden is an interactive teaching tool in the selection of heat tolerant, waterwise plants, integrated pest management, and alternative landscaping techniques.

The walk begins at 1:00 p.m. in the garden located in front of the Jacob A. Hasbrouck Building on SUNY Ulster's Stone Ridge campus. The Tea and Tour of Victoria's Gardens in High Falls immediately follows at 2:30—4:30pm. The cost of the tours, talk and tea is \$15 per person. You'll also receive a comprehensive list of waterwise plants to help you start your own Xeriscape Garden.
