

## BEEF CATTLE – LB

Judging: Thursday, following Showmanship, Cattle Show Ring  
 Premiums: Classes LB-1 through LB-37 Blue – 20 units; Red – 15 units; White – 10 units

- Review Large Animal Rules at beginning of Section L.
- First time exhibitors may enter up to a total number of **3** cattle in Division LB. Return exhibitors may enter up to a total number of **6** cattle in Division LB.
- Judge will consider: (a) appearance of animal; (b) presentation of animal.
- All animals must be shown without horns.
- Classes with a "U" in the number are Ulster County only and not eligible for State Fair (i.e. LBU-38).
- **Show ring attire:** Exhibitors must wear a western or polo shirt (color is not important) and good dark jeans or dress pants. Clean boots or solid leather shoes should be worn. Sneakers are unacceptable. No Hats are allowed.

## **BEEF SHOWMANSHIP**

(Must be entered on Entry Form)

Judging: Thursday, Immediately following Dairy Show., Cattle Show Ring

- LB-39 Novice Showmanship - members who have not shown before.
- LB-40 Junior Showmanship - members under 14 yrs. of age as of Jan.1 of current year (shown before).
- LB-41 Senior Showmanship - Members 14 yrs. and older as of Jan.1 of current year (shown before).
- LB-42 Handler Class Members (all ages) who do not own their own beef cow. Requires one hour of barn duty.

Showmanship will be judged on:

- (1) Consideration to clipping of head, ears, tail, etc. for best advantage. Cleanliness & condition of hide & hair;
- (2) control of animal by exhibitor, poise & coolness of exhibitor, skill in showing animal and overall knowledge of the animal project;
- (3) personal appearance of exhibitor including neatness & cleanliness of clothing. Sneakers are unacceptable, leather shoes should be worn.

Judging: Saturday, 3:30 p.m., Cattle Show Ring

- CO-U01 Animal and exhibitor costumed. Ribbons only. Participants should turn in a short description of costume (to be read) at announcer's booth.
