

## GOATS – LE

Judging: Thursday, following Showmanship, 4-H Sheep Ring  
 Premiums: Classes LE – 1 through LE – 118      Blue – 15 units; Red 10 units; White – 5 units

- Review Large Animal Rules at beginning of Section L.
- Exhibitors must be able to produce registration papers on request for purebred registered animals.
- Goats may be either owned or non-owned but must fit under either (a) or (b) listed below.
  - (a) All owned goats must be personally owned, registered and cared for by the Youth Exhibitor on or before June 1 of the current year. Dual ownership or syndicates are not allowed.
  - (b) All non-owned goats must be designated in the exhibitor's name and cared for by that exhibitor by no later than June 1st of the current year. Non-ownership is not available to youth already owning recorded grade or registered dairy goats. Dual designation of one animal is not permitted.
- All dairy goats must be shown without horns. Horned breeds may enter with committee approval.
- No unneutered bucks.
- Classes with a "U" in the number are Ulster County only and not eligible for State Fair (i.e. L-U114).
- **You are responsible for the care of your animal/s during the fair. This includes:**
  - **clean bedding at all times**
  - **fresh food & water available at all times**
  - **proper sturdy containers for food and water (clearly labeled with your name)**
  - **bringing food (and water if desired) from home**
- You must volunteer a minimum of 4 hours barn duty during the fair.
  - this can be done in segments, or all in one day. Coordinate with Barn Manager
  - duties include watching all animals in barn, making certain no one bothers the animals, that all animals have water, and answering questions from the public.
- **Show ring attire:** Exhibitors must wear a clean white polo or button down shirt with white pants. A belt is required. Boots or solid leather shoes must be worn.

## PET GOATS

- LE-U114 This class is for goats that are not show/breeding quality and are being raised as pets or purebred goats over 2 years who have never freshened. These goats will be judged on grooming, cleanliness, health, vigor, and gentleness. Entries can be purebred, mixed breed, does, or wethers. .

## GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

(Must be entered on Animal Entry Form)

Judging: Thursday, 10:00 am, 4-H Sheep Ring

- Proper attire for exhibitors will be a white shirt and white pants.  
LE-115 Novice Showmanship - members in their first year of showing.  
LE-116 Junior Showmanship - members under 14 yrs. of age as of Jan.1 of current year (shown before)  
LE-117 Senior Showmanship - members 14 yrs. and older as of Jan.1 of current year (shown before)  
LE-U118 Handling Class – members may borrow a goat from another 4-H member. Requires one hour of barn duty.

- Goats must be trained in the use of carts or packs. Any untrained animals will be removed from the show. Does and wethers are eligible for this section.
