

SMALL ANIMALS SECTION – C

- **NO SALE OF ANIMALS AT THE FAIR. Auction is the exception.**
- **You are responsible for the care of your animal/s during the fair. This includes:**
 - **clean bedding at all times**
 - **fresh food & water available at all times**
 - **providing proper sturdy containers for food & water**
 - **bringing food (and water if desired) from home**
 - **clearly labeling container with your name**
- You must volunteer a minimum of 4 hours per animal barn duty during the fair.
 - this can be done in segments, or all in one day. Coordinate with Barn Manager.
 - duties include watching all animals in barn, making certain no one opens cages or bothers the animals, that all animals have water, and answering questions from the public.
- A maximum of 12 rabbits can be entered in breed classes or 1 pet rabbit. You can not enter both classes.
- All animals must be in place by 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday.
- ALL ANIMALS MUST BE INSPECTED BEFORE ENTERING BARN. If placed in unassigned area without supervision, that animal will be moved to the proper area by the Barn Manager.
- All animals must be in show quality condition...clean, healthy, vigorous, mature and free from lice and mites. Poultry must be fully feathered. ANY SICK, DISEASED OR DIRTY ANIMALS WILL BE IMMEDIATELY REMOVED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BARN MANAGER.
- Exhibitor must be present for judging unless otherwise stated.
- Animals must be owned and cared for by the exhibitor as part of the member's 4-H project before June 1 of current year.
- FEEDING, WATERING AND CLEANING UP of your animals is the responsibility of the exhibitor. The exhibitor must supply containers for feed and water. Members not abiding this rule will forfeit their premiums.
- BREED and VARIETY must be listed on the entry form and also labeled on the cage card.
- All animals are expected to remain in their respective barn areas except when being shown.
- **Anyone showing a rabbit MUST attend Rabbit Fair Orientation!**
- Leased animals must be registered on or before June 1.
- Appropriate 4-H attire is required at all times (see page 3). See specific animal species for show ring requirements.
