

RABBITS – CB

Judging: Tuesday, 4:00 pm, Show Tent
 Premiums: Classes CB-1 through CB-237 Blue – 6 units; Red – 4 units; White – 2 units

- Review Small Animal Rules at beginning of Section C.
- Bring carrier cages for show.
- County 4-H Dress Code required. Refer to page 2.
- Members are limited to a total of 12 entries in the breed classes (CB-1-CB-228). Doe and litters will be limited to one per member. The 4-H Staff reserves the right to limit entries due to cage availability.
- Meat entries are limited to a total of 6 entries plus one meat pen.
- Pet rabbits are limited to one entry.
- **Exhibitor or designated 4-H'er** (as recorded with Show Coordinator) **must be present for judging.**
- Rabbits must be owned and cared for by the exhibitor as part of the member's 4-H project before June 1 of current year.
- All animals must be in show quality condition, clean, healthy, vigorous, mature and free from lice and mites. Any sick or diseased animals will be immediately removed at the discretion of the Barn Manager.
- Breed and variety must be listed on the entry form and also on the Small Animal Cage Card. If your rabbit is mixed breed indicate breed as mixed.
- An individual who is entered in the breed class may not enter the pet class and vice versa.
- **All rabbits must have identifying ear numbers tattooed in their left ear.** Ear number must be on Entry Form
- Purebred rabbits will be judged according to the ARBA Standard of Perfection and the Modified Danish system of judging. There is a pet class for mixed breed rabbits. Purebred rabbits that do not meet the ARBA standards should be shown in class CB-233.
- No exhibitor or spectator will be permitted behind the judges' table during judging.
- Every exhibitor must sign up to work in the building for a minimum of 4 hours during the fair. The job will entail answering visitors' questions, checking that rabbits have water at all times, and watching that visitors do not open cages or bother the rabbits.
- **NO SALE OF RABBITS AT THE FAIR. AUCTION IS THE EXCEPTION.**
- Classes with a "U" in the number are Ulster County only and not eligible for State Fair (i.e. CB-U228).
- **No faxed entries**
- No substituting rabbits. Rabbits entered on entry form, must be brought to fair or scratched.
- Leased animals must enter the Pet Class.
- **Show ring attire:** Exhibitors must wear a white long-sleeved lab coat or long-sleeved white dress shirt with a 4-H chevron. Shirts should have no writing or logos that will be visible through the lab coat. Hair should be pulled back and out of your face.

DOE & LITTER CLASS

CB-U238 Animals to be uniform in size and colors recognized for breed. All to be from the same Dam and Sire. Animals must be healthy and vigorous. Must be 4 to 6 weeks old.

RABBIT MEAT CLASS

Judging: During Breed Show

- Entry limit is a total of 6 plus 1 meat pen

CB-U229 Fryer, 10 wks. and under, 3-5 lbs.

CB-U230 Roaster, 6 months and under, 5-8 lbs.

CB-U231 Stewer, over 6 months, over 8 lbs.

CB-U232 Meat Pen, 3 rabbits, same breed and variety, 10 weeks and under, 3-5 lbs.

RABBIT AUCTION CLASSES

- Details/Requirements in 4-H Livestock Auction Section CG

CG-U21 Fryer, 3-5 lbs, generally 10 weeks and under

CG-U22 Roaster, 5-8 lbs, generally 6 months and under

CG-U23 Stewer, over 8 lbs, generally over 6 months

CG-U24 Meat Pen, 3 rabbits, same breed and variety, 3-5 lbs, generally 10 wks and under

OTHER RABBIT CLASSES

- This class is for rabbits that are not a recognized breed or purebred rabbits that do not meet breed standards, but are considered pets. These rabbits will be judged on grooming, cleanliness, health, vigor and confirmation. One pre-entry is allowed.

RABBIT SHOWMANSHIP

Judging: Tuesday, concurrent with Rabbit Breed Show

- Exhibitors evaluated on personal appearance including neatness & cleanliness of clothing. White long sleeved shirt or coat recommended.
- Evaluation includes control of animal by exhibitor, poise of exhibitor, and skill in showing animal to best advantage.

CB-234 Novice Showmanship - members who have not shown before.
CB-235 Junior Showmanship - members under 14 years of age as of Jan. 1 of current year (shown before)
CB-236 Senior Showmanship - members 14 years and older as of Jan. 1 of current year (shown before)
CB-237 Handling Class - members may borrow a rabbit from another 4-H member. Requires one hour of barn duty.

RABBIT COSTUME CLASS

Judging: Saturday, 3:30 p.m., Cattle Show Ring

CO-U01 Animal and Exhibitor costumed. Ribbons only. Participants should turn in short description of costume (to be read) at announcer's booth.
