

Master Showmanship

Goals

- To encourage interaction with a variety of animals
- To encourage an increased animal skill level
- To recognize excellence in showmanship
- To recognize mastery

Overview

The Master Showmanship event is offered to all youth 14 years and older who enter a senior Showmanship Class at the fair. The Showmanship categories are: Beef, Dairy, Dog, Goats, Poultry, Rabbits, and Sheep. The top two blue ribbon participants who **signed up** will be participants in the Master Showmanship class.

Eligibility

- Youth **MUST** enter a Senior Showmanship class as a fair entry.
- Youth **MUST** sign up/enter the Master Showmanship Class by the conclusion of the species showmanship class on the day of the species show.
- When necessary, entries may be limited by class placement.
- Once an individual has earned the title of Master Showman, they are no longer eligible to participate in the contest.

Recognition:

- The Master Showmanship representatives of each species will receive recognition
- The highest composite score will be the Master Showman
- The Master Showman will be invited back to assist in the judging of their species at the next year's fair.
- The Master Showman will receive a trophy.



Note: The educator will determine the animal categories after July 15.
