

LARGE ANIMALS SECTION – L

- D. Classes with a “U” in the number are Ulster County only and not eligible for State Fair.

- **HEALTH CERTIFICATES MUST ACCOMPANY EACH ANIMAL AND MUST BE PRESENTED TO BARN MANAGER IMMEDIATELY UPON ARRIVAL.** All animals must be free of warts and/or ringworm. See Livestock Health requirements attached to this Fair Book.
- Veterinary documentation of Rabies Vaccination must be presented when the animal enters the fairgrounds for Cattle, Horses, Sheep, Dogs, and Cats. All animals must be vaccinated according to current dates and guidelines of Ag & Markets.
- All animals must be “Halter Broke” and be able to be led and shown safely by the 4-H member. Cornell Cooperative Extension staff maintain the right to dismiss any project animal that poses a safety concern to Cloverbuds, 4-H participants or the public.
- Limit two entries per class, unless otherwise stated. Judging in 4-H by Modified Danish System. (When two entries are shown in the same class, another 4-H member may show the second animal.)
- Animals exhibited must be shown in a single class to compete in Showmanship or group classes with the exception of the Handler Class.
- Unless otherwise noted, animals exhibited must be owned & cared for by the Exhibitor by no later than June 1st of current year. **THE CERTIFICATE OF OWNERSHIP/LEASE MUST BE AVAILABLE AT THE FAIR AT ALL TIMES, SHOWING OWNERSHIP OF THE ANIMAL BY THE EXHIBITOR.**
- Animals must be shown to be eligible for a premium.
- No working on animals between the hours of 11:00 p.m. & 5:00 a.m.
- Flagrant violators of Fair rules will receive warnings & persistent violators will be sent home with no guarantee of premiums paid.
- Ulster County Fair Personnel will assign spaces in areas that contain both Open and 4-H Exhibitors.
- Animals cannot be released until Sunday, 6:00 p.m.
- Animals may enter the fair on Monday, Aug. 2 from 9:00 am – 2:00 pm or on Tuesday, Aug. 3 from 9:00 am – 2:00 pm.
- The exhibitor or a family member must be present when animals are unloaded to identify animals.
- All animals must be in place by 3 PM Tuesday.
- **NO CATTLE WITH HORNS** - All exhibitors are expected to do Barn Duty. See Barn Manager or Fair Board Superintendent for specific requirements.
- Appropriate 4-H attire is required at all times(see page 3). See specific animal species for show ring requirements.
