## **Dig It Now: Plant It Later!** *Get Involved in Our 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Great Plant Swap & Sale*

Wanna make a trade? How about some myrtle for Lily of the Valley? Tired of your Hosta? Looking for some Cone Flowers or Black Eyed Suzie's? We have just the place for you to turn in your old plants and get something new. Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County Master Gardeners will host its *5<sup>th</sup> Annual Great Plant Swap & Sale*, Saturday, June 7, 2003 at the Kingston Peace Park, located on the corner of North Front and Crown Streets in uptown Kingston. The Swap and Sale begins at 9 am and will last until plants are gone. Swappers get the first pick with a special "*Swappers Only*" hour from 9-10 am.

All you need to do is dig your plants now, divide, separate and repot. Check them for pests, water regularly and identify by common or Latin name. On Friday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, between 9:00 am and noon, or 4 pm to 6 pm bring your healthy, well cared for plants to Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County, 10 Westbrook Lane, Kingston. The vouchers work as even swaps (six 2" pots brought in equal six 2" pots at the swap) or as upgrades (six 2" pots brought in equal three 4" pots at the swap). Stop by Saturday, June 7<sup>th</sup> from 9 am to 10 am to trade vouchers for plants. Swappers get first pick! After 10 am all remaining plants will be offered for sale. There's no need to bring a plant to get a plant! Stop at Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster
