Ulster County 4-H Offers Popular Vet Science Series

Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County's 4-H Youth Development Program and SUNY Ulster Vet Tech Program are pleased to offer their **Veterinary Science Series** on 5 consecutive Thursdays, starting March 3, 2005 from 6:30 to 8:00 pm at SUNY Ulster. The program gives young people a chance to explore the broad scope of veterinary medicine and animal health through the *Normal Animal* curriculum and hands-on learning taught by area Veterinarians. Some of the topics covered include: animal attitude and behavior; skin, membranes, body temp, pulse and respiration; and health, cleaning, and disinfections. The course, which was introduced last year and proved to be so successful that two separate sessions were sold-out, is open to all Ulster County youth ages 13-19. The fee is \$10. Space is limited to the first 20 paid registrants and will be on a first come first served basis.
