With the peak bloom period arriving annually any time between April 10th and May 15th these breathtaking views will soon be here, and Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County has a guide that will help sightseers take in the beautiful view. The ***Self-Guided Apple Blossom Tour*** brochure, with suggested routes to follow for a drive through the main fruit growing areas in Ulster County, includes a history of fruit growing; facts about the types of fruit and predominate varieties grown here; and a blossom guide to help viewers know what they are looking at.
