Cornell Experts Share Strategies For Maintaining High Use Public Fields

Cornell Cooperative Extension Hudson Valley Commercial Horticulture Program will hold a day-long training featuring information about alternative and least invasive pest management strategies for those responsible for maintaining public recreation fields and grounds. ***Winning Fields on a Limited Budget***, Wednesday, July 27, 2005 from 8 am to 4 pm at the Goshen Central Schools Board of Education Building, 227 Main St, Goshen will focus on athletic field management strategies for all public school ground maintenance professionals; municipal parks and recreation professionals; and ground maintenance professionals at area colleges and universities. Experts from Cornell University will discuss a broad spectrum of issues surrounding the maintenance of high use fields. Pesticide re-certification credits are available.
