New 4-H Youth Sewing Club Comes to Kingston
Club Currently Seeking Members and Adult Volunteers

Attention youth ages 10-12, want to learn a new skill, make new friends and become involved in 4-H? Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County's 4-H Youth Development Program is pleased to announce a new hands-on sewing club designed for youth.

The 4-H Youth Sewing Club will meet on Tuesdays, from 3:00pm to 5:00pm, beginning January 8, 2008 through March 2008, at the Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County's Education Resource Center located at 10 Westbrook Lane (near Hannaford Plaza) in Kingston. The 4-H Youth Sewing Club will be taught by Master Sewer, Kay Peischel.

Participants will learn the basics of sewing by hand and using a sewing machine and will determine their own sewing project. Some of the project options could include an apron, a skirt, a pillow or a mini quilt. The focus of the club will be to make, submit and model an item for the annual 4-H Clothing Revue in May.

Adults with previous sewing experience are also needed to volunteer for one-on-one instructions of the youth members.
