Free Wi\$e Up Women Financial Education Program in Stone Ridge
Helps Women Plan for Their Financial Future

Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County will be hosting Wi\$e Up Women, a special financial education program specifically designed to help women ages 17 - 45 years of age become more financially savvy. The program will be Wednesday, July 25 from 5:30pm to 7:00pm at the Stone Ridge Public Library at 3700 Main St. in Stone Ridge. Registration is limited to 15 participants. Pre-registration is required by Tuesday, July 24.

Wi\$e Up Women will teach women how to plan and take charge of their finances. Participants will learn how to better manage their money, credit cards and credit card debt, how to build and use credit responsibly, develop record keeping and budgeting skills, how to save money for a financially secure future, emergencies and important long term goals, and more. All in a comfortable environment that encourages questions and discussions.

It's a sad fact that most women aren't planning for their financial future. Studies show that, compared to men, women: are more likely to carry credit card debt and live paycheck to paycheck; are more intimidated by financial issues; earn less; have smaller retirement benefits; and are poorer in retirement. This informative program will help guide participants toward a brighter financial future.
