**Zone Tillage Twilight Meeting at Gill Farms in Hurley**

Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster and Orange Counties will be hosting a Zone Tillage Twilight Meeting as part of the Summer Vegetable Twilight Series at Gill Farms located on Hurley Mountain Rd. in the Town of Hurley on Wednesday, July 2 from 6:00pm to 8:00pm.

This program includes equipment demonstrations and sweet corn field comparisons of zone tillage to conventional tillage. Zone tillage is a reduced tillage method that improves soil quality and is gaining prominence in the Northeast.

The fee is \$10 per farm that covers any number of family members or employees that would like to attend. Pre-Registration is encouraged by Monday, June 30. The fee for walk-ins the day of the meeting is \$20. Two pesticide re-certification credits are offered to eligible participants.
