Workshop Offered to Commercial Farmers

With the increase in production of diversified crops that require the use of small sprayers, commercial growers have a need to learn more about their selection and their effective uses. A workshop hosted by Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster and Orange Counties specifically for commercial growers, both conventional and organic, will take place on Tuesday, May 12, 2009 at Lawrence Farms located on Frozen Ridge Road in Newburgh from 5:00pm to 6:30pm. There is a fee of \$20 per farm attending, if pre-registered before Wednesday, May 6. Fee is \$30 per farm attending the day of program.

Dr. Andrew Landers, from the Department of Entomology, NYSAES at Cornell University will cover such topics as the effective and efficient use of small applicators, purchasing small sprayers to meet individual needs, nozzle selection options and calibrating your sprayer.
