Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County's (CCEUC) Master Gardeners will help gardeners add style and flair to their gardens with the information they present at this year's Garden Day on Saturday, April 10 at SUNY Ulster in Stone Ridge. This full day event will run from 8:30am to 4:00pm and boast 16 hands-on and how-to classes for all gardeners from the newest beginners to the most advanced veterans. This year's theme, "Garden Styles" features an array of experts talking on a variety of the hottest trends in gardening designs from all over the globe.

The days featured presentation will be, "BANG FOR THE BUCK: NON-STOP PLANTS FOR YOUR GARDEN" with keynote speaker, Bob Hyland. Color your garden in style this season! Bob will showcase non-stop perennials, shrubs, vines, ornamental grasses and seasonal annuals that yield a high rate of return on your investment. He'll talk about new and underused plants that reward you with vigor, presence, and low maintenance to make your garden a visual treat in all seasons. After 25 years in public garden administration, Bob now co-owns and manages Loomis Creek Nursery, an acclaimed regional retail nursery specializing in garden-worthy plants and pots for Hudson Valley gardens.

In addition to a day full of great classes, free soil testing and plant identification will be available.

Participants can choose 4 separate classes for the day. **Pre-registration is recommended to ensure class choices.** The cost for 4 classes and a full day of garden advice is \$30 per person before Wednesday, April 7, or \$35 at the door.
