## **Learn Photojournalism During Six-week 4-H Youth Workshop**

Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County's 4-H Youth Development Program is now offering a free Digital Photojournalism 4-H Youth Workshop starting January 9 from 2pm to 4:30pm and running for six consecutive Sundays through the winter.

The program is for youth ages 9 to 19, who are required to have a digital camera. Youth will work as participants in their own "publishing firm" charged with creating an online photo magazine featuring horses, rabbits, and other animals in the 4-H animal science program. Participants will also explore other subjects such as architecture, landscapes, still life and nature. The youth will learn how to shoot, edit and digitally retouch images as well as design and publish the online magazine using Wordpress. There will also be an opportunity to produce a print-on-demand "4-H Ulster County Showcase" magazine.

This program offers youth a chance to learn photojournalism, photo editing and website design skills by participating in editorial meetings, creating an editorial budget, taking on photography assignments, and then working as editors to create photographic and editorial content for the web and print media. The participants are responsible for going out "on assignment" with an adult to meet with 4-Hers and photograph various subjects. Additionally, the workshop will feature guest speakers to include professional photographers, editors and journalists.

The workshop will be held at the Cornell Cooperative Extension of Ulster County 4-H offices in Kingston, which is located at 10 Westbrook Lane, Kingston, NY 12401. We are also looking for adult volunteers to help with this program.
